

SOSC Membership Requirements:

There will be a one time initiation fee of \$20.00 assessed to all members the first time they join the club.

Dues are \$48.00 per year. Dues will be prorated for persons joining after the January meeting at \$4.00 per month remaining in the year.

Annual membership fees will be payable on the date of the January meeting, and that membership will be valid through the January meeting of the following year.

Attendance

Members are encouraged to attend all meetings but must attend at least 3 meetings per year. Any member who fails to attend three regular club meetings during the year shall be placed on inactive status. It is intended that each member will be active in the functions of the club, and this clause is inserted to ensure that no person shall enjoy the privileges of membership without active participation.

Work Days

All members are required to help in two work days or fund raisers annually. Work days are defined as a scheduled gathering of club members to work on some type of improvement to the club and it's facilities or an individual (having at least one club member witness) performing some type of work that betters the club. Work days also include working as an assistant to the match officer in any of the club's matches. Failure to get in the two required work days will result in the member being placed on inactive status. Work days may be purchased in lieu of participating in a work day for \$48.00 per work day missed.

Safety

Safety of our members, their guests, and the general public is the top priority for all club members. All new members will receive a copy of our Safety DVD. They must watch the Safety DVD and then go through a safety briefing with the club's Safety Officer or his designee. After such training, they will be given the combination to the locks on the gate and club house.

All bullets must impact the dirt berm or cones on that particular range. Use the appropriate target frame to ensure proper bullet strikes. There is a dwelling approximately 600 yards north and 15 degrees east of our range.

A member may bring as many guests as they can safely oversee. All guests must be on the same range as their member host.

The range is open from sunup to sunset 7 days a week. We do have regularly scheduled matches and they have priority for their particular range. You may shoot on the other ranges but out of courtesy, please let the Match Director know you are on another range.
